MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
August 24, 2022

A meeting was held pursuant to notice at the Town Hall in Accomac, Virginia at 7:30 pm on Wednesday, August 24, 2022.

Call to Order:

Meeting was called to order at 7:28pm.

Old Business:

Chamber ESVA Grant – no update

Ditch Clean-Out – no update

Compilation and Rewrite of Town Ordinances – P. Smith reported council members met about Town ordinances and will continue to meet on the second Wednesday of every month at 9AM.

Town Ordinances Software Costs - Mary Dahlke spoke with someone about this and they never got back with her. She did some research herself on Adobe PDF software that allows you to convert PDFs to editable documents, but it costs \$14.99 per month with one year commitment. Another possibility is ScanWriter for Apple products, but it again will cost. Tabled pending ordinance work sessions.

Town Sewage – P. Smith reported that the county grant incorrectly stated that the Town of Accomac would get \$4 million for sewage, but Karen Doran will try to get grant reworded to correctly say Accomack County would receive the funds, not Town of Accomac. They have a phone meeting scheduled to provide clarification.

New Business and Motions:

Approval of Minutes – S. Troyer made motion to approve July 2022 Meeting Minutes with change to meeting place to Town Hall, rather than Tasley Fire Hall. C. Lewis seconded. Unanimous voice vote.

Approval of Revenue & Expenditures Report – J. Lewis made motion to approve July 2022 Revenue & Expenditure Report. S. Troyer seconded. Unanimous voice vote.


Final FY2022-2023 Budget – Final budget of \$112,500. There being no further discussion on the budget, J. Lewis made motion to approve the budget and C. Newman seconded. Unanimous voice vote.



Hines spoke with Chris Vistall at VDOT and the Town of Accomac is on their schedule to repair broken sidewalks, as well as to spray the sidewalks and repair the streets. T. Hines also compiled a list of property owners whose trees/bushes were overgrown and will continue to approach folks; most were accommodating.
